## **Talents**

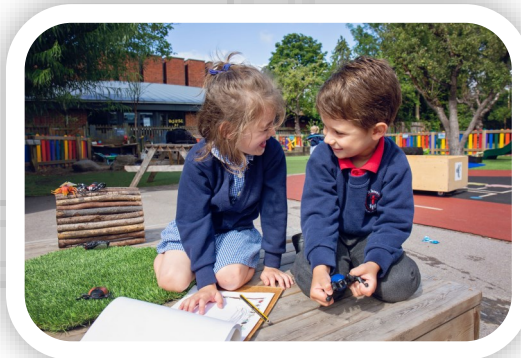
**a willingness to use and develop our gifts. This means we learn respectfully**

## Key Information

- We are a Roman Catholic Voluntary Aided Primary School providing education for approximately 330 children aged 3 - 11 years
- Our school building and grounds are owned by the Diocese of Portsmouth. The school has very close links with the Parish of Corpus Christi, which is on the same site. Canon Simon Thomson, our Parish Priest, acts as our school chaplain and takes an active interest in all aspects of school life, especially celebrating our school Masses.
- All children in our school participate in a daily worship
- We have a pre-school that takes children from 3 to rising 5; it provides full day care during term-time only.
- We currently admit 45 children a year
