



Sports Premium Statement 2020-2022

Our vision at St Teresa's Catholic Academy is to use our School Sports Premium to create a culture that encourages all children to be active and have a positive attitude towards physical activities and healthy lifestyles.

In 2020 – 2021 St Teresa's received £18 690 School Sport Premium. The intention was to use this money to raise standards in curriculum Physical Education, School Sport, Physical Activity and Healthy living. However, due to the government lockdowns, school closures and subsequent safety considerations for the pandemic control, much of that budget did not get spent.

We were also unable to participate in inter-school sport or invite any further external coaches coming in to support sport in school. As we were unable to share equipment in PE lessons our curriculum had to be adapted and as such specific units such as Gymnastics and Dance were not taught. These gaps in children's learning have been identified and will be a focus for this academic year.

St Teresa's will be carrying over the unspent budget to this academic year, 2021-2022. Our intention is to spend this sum on improving and enhancing the delivery of all sport and games across the school so children are physically more active. In addition we will be providing more opportunities for them to engage in physical activities outside of their PE lessons and participate in competitive sports.
